Revelation Outline Chapter Ten

Revelation 10:1

- Angel or Jesus.
- “Angel” was robed in a cloud.
- Rainbow that shone like an emerald encircled the throne.
- GOD is one in three and no other is of His Holy Deity.
- Ezekiel’s experience of GOD’S Throne room.
- Moses did, and the Angels in GOD’S presence seem to absorb and reflect GOD’S illumination.
- Jesus hidden in literary form.
- It is estimated John was in his mid 90’s around 100 AD.
- The man assisting John, as the Apostle John dictated, was Polycarp.
- In the Gospel John, John gives to us details that were not in the other Gospels.
- Jesus instructed John to write down what he had seen, what was, and what would be.
- For a time the Gospel of John had names added to its conclusion as endorsement of authenticity of the famous teachers and preachers of their day, who knew John was at Ephesus before he died and his words were true.

Revelation 10:2

- Jesus is showing His Deity as He is upon the earth so large that one foot is placed on the sea, and again does not submerge in the water, while the other is placed on land.
- The now open scroll, now appears to be little. It is in the hand of GOD, in this case the hand of Christ.
- Reminder: In scripture, sea is representative of Gentiles, while land always represents Israel and the Jewish people.

Revelation 10:3

- Reminder: Lion of Judah is a Jewish description of Jesus.
- Revelation 10:3 from the King James: And cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices.
- When Jesus speaks it is the thundering voice of Almighty GOD as in the Holy Spirit.
- When GOD has spoken audibly to us, believers heard His words while unbelievers hear only thunder.

Revelation 10:4

- This is the only place within Revelation that Father GOD Himself spoke and told John not to write this detail down.
- Something stupendously amazing.
- Father GOD did not allow John to record it for only He knows the exact hour of the Rapture.
- The Church will be Jesus' Bride. He the Lord is courting us.
- We are whisked away. Taken out of harm's way; then the real trouble begins.

Revelation 10:5-7

- Jesus just swore His oath again to Jehovah His Almighty Father as He institutes THE mystery of GOD.
- Mysteries of GOD.
- At the 7th Trumpet, the last Trumpet, THE mystery of GOD will take place.
- We also just saw that at the last Trumpet the Rapture will take place.
- The Golden rule of prophetic interpretation is this: When the plain sense makes sense seek no nonsense.
- Just before the 7th Trumpet Jesus proclaims that THE mystery of GOD will be fulfilled.
- In Greek the word THE in front of a subject always means the top or paramount.
- Say to them, 'The days are near when every vision will be fulfilled.
- Jesus is stating that all prophecy, the entire point of the Bible is about to be forever fulfilled.
- THE paramount Mystery of GOD is how He became flesh, fulfilled His own Law, and redeemed sinful human beings that believe in Him.

Revelation 10:8-10

- The Gospel or good news of Christ is as sweet as honey in our mouth, but once we are Saved and redeemed, on the inside our walk with Christ is hard to match our talk of Christ.
- Our sinful nature gets in our own way of Jesus' way.

Revelation 10:11

- Jesus told John he must again prophecy to every tribe, tongue, and nation.
- Ezekiel Chapter 1: His similar experience in Heaven:
- Ezekiel was ordered to eat the scroll, to take the living word of GOD into his actual being.
- Jesus is the living word of GOD. He was as sweet as honey in Ezekiel's mouth and as bitter as wormwood in his stomach.
- In Revelation chapter 10 the scroll is now open in Jesus hand.
- Each series of Judgements opens the next.

- The Seals open the Trumpets while the Trumpets open the bowls or vials.
- The Trumpets actually conclude the scroll.
- The Title deed is not mentioned again.
- The scroll is passed onto mankind by its new owner Jesus our Christ.
- Father GOD gave it to Christ when He alone is proven worthy to purchase the deed and redeem those within the earth.
- Jesus paid a steep Spiritual price beyond our comprehension.
- Jesus passes the scroll onto John, the last remaining Apostle, a blood relative of Jesus.
- John then has to consume the living word of GOD into His inner being. Fulfilling the mystery of GOD.
- *For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.*
John 3:16 KJV
- The scroll is sweet in John's mouth but bitter in his being.
- GOD'S Wrath comes from GOD Himself from His Throne. Not the scroll.
- A promise from Jehovah Almighty unto our Lord and Savior Jesus.
