Revelation 21 Outline

Revelation 21:1

- ❖ The 1000 year Millennial Kingdom which is called the day of the Lord when Jesus returns.
- ❖ This is the promise of Jesus-to take His Bride the Church and all who believe in Him into the Lord's Kingdom.
- ❖ Psalm 104:5 states that the foundations of the Earth will never be removed.
- ❖ In the End Times or Last Days just before Jesus returns that there will be 3 specific ways mankind will be in defiance unto Almighty GOD:
 - Emotionally: Those in rebellion cannot endure sound doctrine.
 - Historically: revisionist history
 - Intellectually: Following demonic myths and fables; false teachers
- ❖ Heaven and Earth

Revelation 21:2-4

- ❖ Father GOD also gives to us a new home glittering of gold and precious stones suspended in the New Earth's clouds of the sky.
- ❖ The bride and her husband.
- ❖ Jesus has handed the 1000 Millennial Kingdom over to His Father & GOD.
- ❖ Jehovah Almighty makes His dwelling place amongst mankind on a newly remodeled Earth within a New Holy Jerusalem.
- ❖ The first promise at the feast from Jehovah Almighty is His vow that none will die, mourn, cry or have pain.
- ❖ Historical background.
- ❖ Messiah will be of the order of Melchizedek.
- ❖ Melch means King and Izedek means Righteousness.
- ❖ Some say Melchizedek was a man, a foreshadow precursor to Christ, while others believe Melchizedek was the pre-incarnate Christ.

Revelation 20:5-8

- ❖ Revelation was originally one long letter and now Revelation will soon be coming to a close.
- ❖ Jesus reaffirms that He is each our Christ as a human being and our Lord GOD.
- ❖ The Lord referred to Himself as our living water. Jesus said all who come to Him can drink for free and never thirst again.
- ❖ Only the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God overcomes the world.
- ❖ Jesus summarizes that those who deny Him to selfishly live in Sin, face their end.

Revelation 20:9-13

- ❖ The promise that New Jerusalem upon the New Earth will be the home of the Church or Bride of Christ.
- ❖ Jerusalem's will have 12 gates; each one named after one of the 12 Tribes of Israel.

Revelation 20:14-21

- ❖ New Jerusalem will be laid out like a cube.
- ❖ Converting stadia to miles means New Jerusalem will be 1500 miles on every side.
- ❖ The walls will be exactly 24 feet thick.
- ❖ The foundations of the city wall were decorated with precious stones.

Revelation 20:22-27

- ❖ *The sun will no more be your light by day, nor will the brightness of the moon shine on you, for the LORD will be your everlasting light, and your God will be your glory.*

Isaiah 60:19

- ❖ Almighty Father Jehovah says He is making everything anew, a new Heaven, upon a New Earth within a new capital city of Jerusalem for a New Age of eternity. Forever and ever, Amen.
