We will however need supplies for our Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes that we pack in October and thought we might get the list out early since the school supplies are on sale now. We had trouble finding scissors last year in October. So if you would like to help fill our shoeboxes, these are the items we will need: loose leaf paper, markers, scissors, Crayola crayons (others melt), small tablets, pencils, and pens. Toiletries we collect are washcloths, bars of soap (no liquids allowed), combs, toothbrushes (no toothpaste), hair bows and headbands. We also need small toys and books that will fit in a shoebox.
